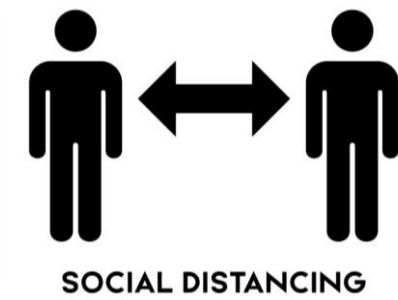
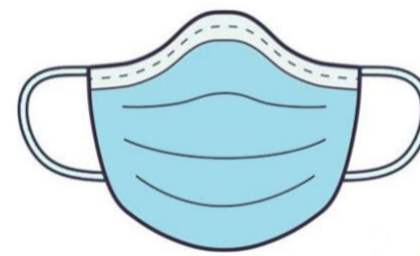


Big Screen TV Moved To Chesterfield Lounge
