

### We are in Grey Alert Status

As of Saturday, December 26<sup>th</sup>, Ontario is in a province-wide lockdown. The following changes will be placed for Bay Haven Care Community.

- Weekly COVID-19 testing is required for all staff providing direct care and all Essential Designated Caregivers.
- Proof of negative test is required for staff providing direct care and Essential Designated Caregivers.
- All other staff are required to be tested every two weeks.
- General visitors are NOT PERMITTED.
